DESCRIPTION OF JOB DUTIES:

Under direction, has primary technical assistance for the Information Systems Branch within the division for assigned computer projects. Provides technical assistance to Information Systems Branch to include the System and Database section during the development and implementation of internal and external programs to be used by both state and federal personnel. Writes complex web based ordering programs, as well as, internal operational programs; programs utilizing the latest tools for web programming to include but not limited to visual basic, hypertext markup language, structured query language and other programming tools. Works with the Informational System Branch to coordinated the work required from each section to complete the development of a complex program to be utilized by other agencies outside of state government such as the Defense Logistics Agency, National Guard Bureau and Tank-Automotive and Armaments Command. Works with Informatino System Branch to create a web based and local application testing environment to test all programs for accuracy before release into production. Assist in the documentation of designed programs to assist other programmers when trouble shooting the developed programs. Performs other duties as assigned.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

EDUCATION:

Graduate of a college or university with a bachelor's degree.

EXPERIENCE:

Must have three years of professional experience in computer programming, systems analysis, systems support and/or computer operating systems.
